We are starting to plan for summer camp and things are already coming together. Several of the places we are planning on having fieldtrips to have already opened their registration. We are excited to be lining up some great fieldtrips for the PK and SA classes this summer.

Summer Camp will run from June 17th - Aug. 16th this year. All the children in the PS class and older, currently attending Little Learners, will automatically be enrolled in our summer camp. If your child will not be attending summer camp, please let us know before the end of March so that your account does not get charged. Once your account is charged the fee, it is **non-refundable**. Your account will be charged the first half of the activities fee on March 31st and the second half will be charged June 1st. We will be sending out summer camp fee information soon. If you have any questions or concerns about the summer camp program, please call the office.

LCPS will be closed Tuesday, March 5th for a student holidays and March 25th - 29th for Spring Break. If your SA child will be attending LLA please let us know. If they will be absent, please remember to mark them absent on the Tadpole App, call, text or email us at least a week prior. As a reminder, if you do not let us know your child will be absent, we will assume they will be here, and your account will be charged the \$25 public school closings fee (even if they do not end up attending). Weather permitting, we will be taking the kids to some of the local parks for a fieldtrip. Please make sure your SA child is here no later than 10am these days. Also, don't forget to pack them a lunch.

On Friday, March 15th we will be celebrating St. Patrick's Day with an all "Green Day" party. You will be receiving an email on what you can contribute. If you have something green in mind that you would like to send in, please reach out to your child's teacher so they can put it on the list. If you are unable to contribute, no worries, just let us know. Don't forget to wear green on this day or you might get pinched!

PNO will be held March 22nd from 6:30pm-11:00pm. Don't forget to sign up and enjoy a night out while the kids have a fun time here at LLA.

We are so excited to host our Annual Egg Hunt this year on Saturday, March 23rd from 10:30-12:30 (rain date March 24th). 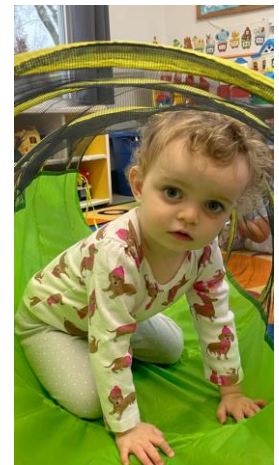
