A Word from the Director

It's hard to believe May has arrived! With spring in full swing and warmer weather hopefully here to stay, we're looking to update the children's spare clothing at the center. Please ensure your child has a complete set of summer clothes available, including pants or shorts, a shirt, underwear, socks, and shoes if possible. As we spend more time outside, accidents tend to increase. Make sure everything is labeled and remember to replace any items you take home. Additionally, your child **must** wear closed-toed shoes; flip-flops and open-toed sandals are not allowed, as this helps keep everyone safe from injuries.

Summer Camp 2026 is approaching quickly. The remaining portion of the activities and materials fee must be paid by June 1st. Summer camp packets will be sent out soon. Please make sure everything is submitted **before** camp begins. You can deliver forms and supplies to the office or directly to your child's classroom teachers. Your child should bring the following items to the center and **leave** them here: a regular bath towel, swimsuit (girls should bring **two-piece** swimsuits; swim shirts will be provided), swimmers (for children who are still in diapers), water shoes (not open-toed), and sunscreen (a sunscreen form must be attached, and sunscreen should be at least SPF 50 and continuous spray). Water shoes may be hard to find if you wait too long, so please purchase them early.

There are still some spots open for summer camp. If you know someone interested, please refer them to us, parent referrals are our highest compliment.

Mother's Day is coming up fast! We want to express our appreciation for all the wonderful moms and grandmas. Enjoy your special day with your kids. All moms and grandmas are invited to join us for breakfast with their children from 7-9:30 am on Friday, May 8th. We're excited to celebrate together!

Kindergarten registration has already begun in all Loudoun County public schools. Little Learners will serve Stuart Weller and Selden's Landing. If your child will **not** attend one of these schools but would like to continue at Little Learners, you'll need to request **special permission** for them to enroll at either location.
