## A Word from the Director

As the school year comes to a close, we are preparing for Summer Camp 2026. Please submit all required paperwork and supplies to the center by June 5, as they are needed for your child to participate.

This summer, each child will receive a camp T-shirt, backpack, water bottle, and towel. These items will stay at the center during camp and be sent home at the end of the summer. Children must also bring a swimsuit (two-piece for girls), closed-toe water shoes, and one bottle of continuous spray sunscreen with SPF 50 or higher to keep at the center.

Pool visits will take place weekly for PS through SA. PS and PK will have assigned pool days from 10:00 to 11:00 am, while SA may choose their preferred days and times. All PS and PK children must wear a life jacket. SA children must wear a life jacket unless they can pass the swim test.

PK and SA classes will enjoy weekly field trips to waterparks and other attractions. SA will also take occasional trips to playgrounds and attend events such as movies and library activities. We will continue to host regular in-house shows and events featuring both returning and new performers. Weekly splash days will include moon bounces, water slides, and other water activities.

The Toddler class will also have a weekly splash day. Information has already been sent home; please sign and return the form if you have not done so yet.

The second half of summer camp fees will be charged on June 1. Please note that these fees are non-refundable once charged.

Little Learners Academy will celebrate its 25th anniversary on June 15. We are grateful to the many families we have served over the years and to our staff members Ms. Christy, Ms. Melissa, and Ms. Divina, who have been with us since the beginning. To mark our 25th year and the first day of summer camp, we will host a small celebration with ice cream and cookies at 3:00 p.m. We hope you can stop by and celebrate with us.

As summer camp begins, there will be some staffing and classroom changes. We are pleased to welcome back Ms. Camille, Ms. Carleigh, and Ms. Lauren. Ms. Savannah will also be helping on Fridays, and Ms. Catherine and Ms. Layla will assist as needed. We also welcome Ms. Kimberly and Ms. Clara, who will join us this summer as assistant camp counselors. Unfortunately, Ms. Yoselin will be out this summer due to foot surgery. Ms. Roneka will also not be with us, as her family is moving to Virginia Beach following her husband's new job opportunity. We wish them both the very best.
